### Introduction

These Terms and Conditions apply to all photography services provided by Eveline Photography. By booking online, paying a booking fee, or confirming a booking by email, you confirm that you have read, understood and agree to these Terms in full.

### Services

Services include portraiture, brand photography, event photography, wedding photography and boudoir photography. Specific details including location, duration and deliverables are agreed at the time of booking.

### Booking & Payment

Bookings are confirmed upon written confirmation. Booking fees or deposits are non-refundable unless otherwise agreed in writing. Final balances must be paid by the due date stated on the invoice.

### Cancellation & Rescheduling

Cancellations more than 30 days before the session will forfeit the booking fee only. Cancellations within 30 days may not be refundable. Rescheduling is subject to availability and at the photographer's discretion.

### Artistic Style

Clients acknowledge familiarity with Eveline Photography's style and agree that editing style, composition and image selection remain the photographer's discretion.

### Copyright & Usage

All images remain the copyright of Eveline Photography under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988. Clients receive a non-exclusive licence for personal or business use relevant to the booking. Images may not be sold, altered or transferred without written permission.

### Boudoir Confidentiality

Boudoir images are treated with strict confidentiality and will never be shared publicly without explicit written consent.

### Image Delivery & Storage

Images are delivered digitally within 7 days unless otherwise agreed. Clients are responsible for backing up their images. Images are not archived beyond 24 months.

### Limitation of Liability

Liability is limited to the total fees paid for the booking. Eveline Photography is not responsible for circumstances beyond reasonable control.

### Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales.
